POLLINATOR GARDEN TOOLBIN BLEVINS GAP NATURE PRESERVE	\$5000
This toolbin near the garden entrance at the trailhead overlook will ensure volunteers have the supplies they need to	care for

this native wildflower area supporting a healthy pollinator population.

FANNING TRAILHEAD KIOSK TOOLBIN | BLEVINS GAP NATURE PRESERVE......\$3000

This toolbin will be installed on the backside of our trailhead kiosk and stocked with tools for trail maintenance and programming at the nearby Little Foot Loop, a trail designed specifically for our youngest hikers.

TRAILHEAD KIOSK | GREEN MOUNTAIN NATURE PRESERVE......(1 REMAINING) \$5000

A large kiosk featuring our trail map and important visitor information will be installed at both ends of the new Green Mountain Trail. Trail entrances are located at Astalot Drive (SOLD) and Riverview Drive (AVAILABLE).

25' BRIDGE ON LEGACY LOOP | HICKORY COVE NATURE PRESERVE......\$8000

A new bridge constructed with steel support beams will replace an existing timber structure.

OBSERVATION BOARDWALK | HICKORY COVE NATURE PRESERVE......\$5000

An approximately 20' T-shaped boardwalk leading to the historic spring house and water trough allowing visitors to observe and appreciate historic features of the property while ensuring these structures are protected from foot traffic.

FOOTBRIDGE ON HIGH TRAIL | MONTE SANO NATURE PRESERVE......\$2500

A small footbridge will cross a wet wash area improving trail access and safety for users.

60' BOARDWALK | MATTHEWS NATURE PRESERVE......\$5000

A boardwalk along Matthews Trail will improve access in a perpetually wet area of the preserve while also protecting the robust plant poulations found in the surrounding area. Located on one of our closed conservation properties, this trail is a popular site for members-only hikes during wildflower season.
