Additional Benefits Information

- **Tuesdays on the Trail:** This is our summer environmental education series for children ages 6-12 years offered each year on Tuesdays in June and July. This program is free to attend but registration is only available to Land Trust members at the Trailblazer giving level or above.
- **Ticket Discounts:** Trailblazer Level Members receive up to 6 discounted tickets to all paid Land Trust education program (such as Nature Play Camp, Plant Identification Workshop, and Wilderness Skills Camp Out). All members at the Pathfinder giving level or above receive up to 6 discounted tickets to ALL Land Trust events (such as Moon Dance) and education programs.
- **Online Store Credit:** You can shop for Land Trust gear and apparel at landtrustna.org/shop. Explorer level members and above receive a special credit to use towards purchases in the online store.
- **Pavilion Rental:** The Land Trust has three pavilions available to reserve for private gatherings. These include Bankhead Pavilion at Monte Sano Nature Preserve, Dale W. Strong Community Pavilion at Harvest Square Nature Preserve, and Terry Education Pavilion at Chapman Mountain Nature Preserve.
